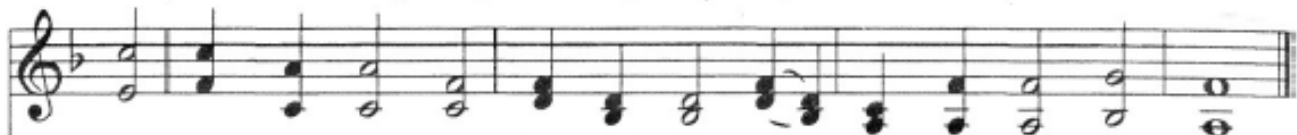


The Love of Christ Who Died for Me
